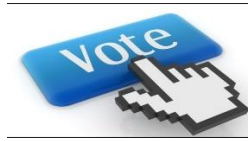




MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS 2020



The 2020 Municipal Election will take place on Saturday, October 17th, 2020. The Municipality of the District of Guysborough will be administering an entirely Electronic Election

- 18 years of age on or before October 8, 2020
- A Canadian Citizen
- A resident of the Municipality of the District of Guysborough

Eligible voters will receive an envelope in the mail which will contain your Voters Information Letter (VIL) with your PIN #. Voting can be done by computer, landline telephone, cell/smart phone, tablet (Voting period: October 8th, 8:00 am – October 17th, 7:00 pm) or any polling station (available on Official Election Day from 8:00 am – 7:00 pm). If you go in person to vote at a polling station, you will be required to bring your VIL with you. If you did not receive the VIL, please contact one of the Returning Officers to register and receive your VIL or PIN #. There is no voting by paper ballot in this election.

Polling Stations will be located throughout the Municipality on Election Day where required.

A poll will be available from October 8th – October 16th (excluding weekends and holidays) from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm and on Official Election Day, October 17th from 8:00 am – 7:00 pm at the Guysborough Municipal Building.
